Policy on Sexual Misconduct Prevention Training

[Keeping Your Ministry Safe]

The Presbytery of Greater Atlanta has a policy that all non-retired clergy, except those retired clergy serving a church in some form (interim, parish associate), shall receive or repeat the Sexual Misconduct Prevention Training (Keeping Your Ministry Safe) every three years. (Approved April, 2004)

The training dates for 2005 are:

- Level One: October 25, 2005
(New clergy to the presbytery)
- Level Two: September 27, 2005

Sessions are at Druid Hills Presbyterian Church, 9 AM till Noon.
